Sadly, my beloved wife died last Tuesday. Formally it was an accidental death although she was suffering from cancer. I am not sure how I am going to be affected by this in both the short term or long term.

I will let you know when the funeral is. We had 33 very happy years together.

What I find upsetting is having to answer the same questions over and over again. We had all sorts of protocols for my death which I am following. There is no will and we did not discuss things like funeral arrangements. So, I am following what she did for her father more or less.

When did Caroline die. Tuesday 28th May 2024 at 01:30 AM

What did Caroline die of? At some point between about 9:00 and 11:00 AM on Monday she banged her head while on the toilet and lost consciousness, went into a coma and never woke up. She had a bleed on the brain. The ambulance was with us in under six minutes.

I do not know and do not want to know the exact circumstances I leave that to the Medical Examiner and possibly the coroner.

Were you with her when she died?. No Protocol.
